Budget Hearing began at 7:00 pm. Motion was made by Dan, supported by Linda to approve the 2020-2021 budget as presented. Motion carried.

New Business – Paul I. requested that a millage proposal be added to the August Primary ballot this year for fire department operating and maintenance expenses. The current operational millage will expire this year. He is asking for 2.25 mills over 4 years with funds being used for operational and maintenance expenses and any excess would go into a savings fund earmarked for a new fire truck when needed. Motion was made by Linda, supported by Dan to approve the request. Motion carried. Clerk will contact the township attorney about drawing up language for the ballot.

Bills totaling 15,396.24 were approved for payment. (Dan, Brian)
