Public Comment –

- Becky Fitzpatrick from the public library attended the meeting and informed us that the library needs another trustee.

Fire Department –

- The chiefs meeting was held last month and the emergency response trailer for the county was discussed.
- There has not been response yet from the Federal Government regarding the new radios.
- Continuing education for the firefighters is now being tracked by software, and there are many classes held online.
- There are grant request opportunities that we are currently gathering information to submit.
- The Halloween party plans are underway. The party will be held on October 31, 2022 here at the fire barn.
- The new fire truck is several months out yet.

New Business –

- The gravel that was ordered last year was applied in the township. Limestone was applied on Goodemoot Road, and brine was applied in the township last week.
- Brian handed out information about solar on PA116 land. There are other townships that have passed ordinances and we will look at those ordinances. One of the concerns is the decommissioning of the panels when no longer viable to use.
- There are no maps from the village about drains concerning the water issues with redoing the parking lot. Brian will talk with Brad Clark about this issue. Our parking lot is no longer repairable and needs to be completely revamped.
- Kevin Willison, deputy treasurer, presented the cost of the new computer server and firewall subscriptions for the township. Our operating system is out of date and is in need of replacement. \$8300 is the cost of the server, and the subscription for the firewall is approximately \$1200 for 3 years. Life expectancy is 5 years. Dennis/Dan

Old Business –

- Dennis reported on a meeting that he attended in Brian's stead regarding the Tax Allocation Board. There is more discussion to be had about this board and how we will participate in the future.

Bills totaling \$110,434.23 were approved for payment. Dan/Dennis.
